RESOLUTION to SUPPORT CONSOLIDATION RECYCLING EFFICIENCY GRANT

HEREBY AUTHORIZES the (Ellen Pattermann/Clerk) to act on behalf of the The Town Of Woodville, to: submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for recycling purposes; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete an approved recycling consolidation grant project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the The Town of Woodville will meet the obligations of the Recycling Consolidation Grant project. We understand the importance of continuing the recycling.
